Dear Family Members,

Mr. Fred Rogers said, "Look for the helpers" during times of crisis. We didn't have to look far. Our residents, team members, the community and you, the families of those who live here, have supported our efforts and cooperated with protocols and restrictions we initiated to keep our community safe.

We have zero cases of coronavirus in our community. We remain vigilant in our preventive measures and protocols. When we have a confirmed case, we are prepared to immediately take action to contain and prevent the virus from spreading. We have adequate personal protective equipment (PPE) for team members. And we will inform residents and family members should a case be confirmed.

Just a reminder, **no Visitors are allowed,** except compassionate care visits in end of life cases. These essential visitors must complete a health questionnaire and have their temperature checked before entering the community.
