



Coronavirus (COVID-19) Resident Update

From the Executive Director

Dear Lutheran Village at Miller's Grant Residents,

It is with a heavy heart that I report the passing of a Carroll Lutheran Village community member in connection with COVID-19. She was in her 90s and a recent transfer from a Maryland hospital to CLV's skilled nursing and short-term rehabilitation center. Please pray for her family and for Carroll Lutheran Village as they battle the spread of COVID-19.

Today, we have ZERO cases of COVID-19. Unfortunately, this is a fluid situation and can change at any time.

We continue to take every possible precaution to prevent further spread of the coronavirus. Our entire team is doing their absolute best, every day, to ensure your safety and well being.

I implore you to follow the **Stay-at-Home order issued by Gov. Larry Hogan**. Please do not risk yourself, your loved ones, friends or our team members by venturing outside the community unless it is essential, such as a required health care appointment.

*Last week, on Thursday alone, residents from 16 apartments and six homes left the community, despite our strong recommendation. Out of these, only two were for medical appointments. **If you leave the community, we request you to self-quarantine for 14 days. This is imperative for the health and wellbeing of our residents.***

Our team members are considered essential workers, they will continue to travel to and from our community to provide care and service.



Our No Visitor policy in Health Care and Assisted Living remains in place, along with social distancing guidelines and the screening of essential health care workers and team members. Our Essential Visitor policy remains in place for Residential Living.

Please remember that COVID-19 is particularly hard on people who have underlying health conditions. Those individuals should continue to take every precaution during this pandemic, including staying at home, practicing social distancing and proper handwashing.

We know seeing your loved ones would offer a sense of relief and peace of mind, especially now. We know you miss them; they miss you too. Again, we encourage you to please take advantage of video chats, texting, phone calls and social media, if you haven't already.
