## Maryland's COVID-19 Positivity Rate Drops to Record-Low 3.62%, ICU Levels Decline

- » Daily Positivity Rate Is 3.17%, Third Lowest on Record
- » Total Current Hospitalizations Are 534, ICU Beds Drop Below 120 For First Time Since July 14
- » Baltimore City and Baltimore County Report Lowest Positivity Rates Since Late March

As indicated, per regulatory requirements, Miller's Grant is conducting weekly testing of Health Care and Assisted Living team members.

Last week, Maryland saw its lowest statewide positivity rate since COVID began; although the state's percentages and results from last week's testing are encouraging, we know there will be more positive cases.

We also know that our strong policies and procedures, which are in place, along with our response to these positive cases are critical to mitigating the spread of these cases. Each of you play an important role in keeping the community safe. Please do not remove or pull your mask down when traveling throughout the community.
